


## Breeders' Cup Form Cycle Picks & Analysis Preview

All Predictiform users with subscribed access to any Friday or Saturday Breeders' Cup cards will receive complimentary full card analysis and picks with suggested wagers. We'll discuss form cycle patterns, dirt and turf spread progression, and pricing value.

We'll use last year's Distaff as an example of what you can expect from Predictiform's Form Cycle Picks & Analysis. Here, our Top Value Win Bet just missed at 24/1 but the suggested Exacta had our back for \$111 per \$2. Using the same suggested runners for the Trifecta would have yielded \$283 per \$1.

Think she drew well here getting to save ground before making her typical pounce on the leaders. Tough one to leave out.	
<b>BLUE STRIPE (ARG)</b> POST POSITION: 2 20/1 WEIGHT: 124 LAST RACE: 91 DAYS	The Argentina native wasn't ready for this stage off the plane last year but after wintering has put together a decent west coast campaign coming off a REV/SOFT pattern combo that translates positively to receiving a little extra distance while fresh. Needs to improve to go with these but the price does look plenty fair for a runner on a positive form cycle trajectory leading in. Just the kind of outside invader to surprise a field like this that has been largely familiar with beating each other up all year.	

## Breeders' Cup Classic Winners

The prevailing trend has been the ability to find the Classic winner by simply using runners coming off an 80+ Final Figure. 6 of the 7 last winners met the criteria and you didn't have to be deep as only 1 to 3 runners fell in that 80+ grouping each year.

## 2018 Filly & Mare Sprint

The last double-digit odds winner of this race came in 2018 and highlighted one of the Value Plays algorithm's most impressive exotics hits in this race's history. Structuring a ticket using the Top 5 Value Plays could have scooped the Super Hi-5 Pool or cashed nice payouts on other exotics. The big exotics hits were spurred by NPT Top Value Shamrock Rose coming through at 25/1 while the other NPT in the race #12 Anonymity hit the board at 31/1.

## Breeders' Cup Sprint

At first thought, you might imagine the world's quickest sprinters lining up would result in winners that display blowout speed and large positive dirt spreads with high pace velocity. However, in 23 editions of the BC Sprint, there have actually only been 2 gate-to-wire winners.

Rather than blowout 4F Figure speed, tactical speed has been the important attribute to possess in this grueling spin. In 6 of the last 7 editions, the eventual winner was coming off a mathematically negative dirt spread. 2023 pre-entries feature 3 runners coming off dirt spreads tighter than 0 with Gunite holding the dirt spread most closely resembling the dirt spread of past winners.
